Over this past calendar year, our center events and programming have been significantly impacted as a result of the global pandemic. The center was closed through the spring of 2020. On June 15th, we were excited to hold our soft opening, though we could only house no more than ten people at a time, including staff.

As the summer got underway, our membership adapted to these restrictions by holding remote classes and meeting off center grounds. As summer transitioned to fall, our members adapted once again by learning how to "Zoom" by participating in numerous classes and meetings virtually. It was truly impressive to see their ingenuity so as to participate and engage one another. With that said, our instructors and group facilitators are to be commended as well for their ability to host these events.

Unfortunately, as fall went into winter, there were increased reports of those contracting COVID, and in some case, succumbing to the disease. One of those members, Gary Nickel, was also a center board member and friend to the community of Flushing. We mourn his loss along with all members who passed during this time.

With spring having transitioned to summer, the center if fully open for business without restrictions. We hope this continues into the second half of the year as we look for ways to enhance programing along with increased membership and participation.

A vital area of service provided for Flushing area seniors is the transportation program. This is a volunteer-based program that has been in place at the Senior Center for over 40 years! In the last year, our drivers provided 759 rides for seniors.

Social Services

We provide many Social Services including Medicare/Medicaid Assistance, Bridge Card Assistance, Veterans Benefits Assistance, and Legal Assistance. Information and referral services continue to help an ever-increasing senior population.

We also provide educational classes for those caring for family members to become more capable and confident such as a support group for Alzheimer's Caregivers.
